

My name is Miss Noel Tyler and I am a first dan black belt at ABT Taekwondo in Anchorage, Alaska. Beside my ministry of teaching Taekwondo I am a missionary. I have traveled to many countries including, Kenya, Congo, Rwanda, Burundi, Israel and Mexico. I currently go to Mexico twice a year to the cities of Mexicali and Ensenada to take part in a prison ministry organized by Azusa Pacific University. Each day we go to the prison, we have a team of women who visits with the women inmates and a team of guys who play basketball with some of the guys in prison. The guys also share their testimonies with the guys they are playing basketball with and encourage them. I go with the women and we pray with them and visit with them as well as sometimes play volleyball or soccer. I help supply and organize gift bags for the women consisting of shampoo, soap, lotion, toothpaste and toothbrushes. I have also assisted in fitting hundreds of inmates with reading glasses and providing the book of John from the Bible for them to read. The inmates in Mexico are given very little and these small gifts are a huge blessing and show them God's love through action. It's the family's responsibility to provide these simple items for the inmates, but many don't have family nearby or aren't in touch with their family. I am blessed to be able to serve God in many ways and I try to share the Gospel as much as possible. I encourage everyone to step out and show God's love to those less fortunate. God will always bless you and take care of you.
